The Semmelweis Scanner was named in honor of the Hungarian-Austrian physician, Ignaz Semmelweis. We dedicated our innovation to the early pioneer of antiseptic procedures, who discovered years ahead of the confirmation of germ theory that childbed fever is preventable by hand disinfection.
